John Lothropp, the Lothrop family, and the Lothropp Family Foundation.

Biographical and historical information: The Lothropp Family Foundation was founded by Helen Taber in 1989 in Barnstable, Massachusetts, the home of Rev. John Lothrop. Their primary objective is to preserve and memorialize the historical events in the lives of Rev. John Lothrop and Mark Lothrop and their descendants.
