Scope and Content Note: The collection consists of a 3-volume typescript copy of the *Life of Henry Howard*. The text is accompanied by numerous photographs of Howard from childhood through adulthood. The volumes are dated December 30, 1944.

Historical and Biographical Information: Henry Howard, a prominent chemical engineer at Merrimac Company and Grasselli Chemical Company of Cleveland, was also a passionate yachtsman. In the early 20th century he organized and directed a series of yacht races between the United States, Germany and Spain. He worked to establish the Recruiting Service for the U. S. Shipping Board. He was active in the Boston, Cleveland, and United States Chambers of Commerce.
