Scope and Content Note: A collection of postcards with views of Cape Cod towns and villages from the collections of David Crocker of Mashpee, Massachusetts and Eldon Davidson, as well as other sources. Cards are predominately from the villages of the Town of Barnstable, with the majority being from Barnstable Village. The collection also includes views of the Cape Cod Canal, the cranberry industry, whales and whaling, ships, weir fishing, and lighthouses. Postcards date from approximately 1880 through the 1980s.
